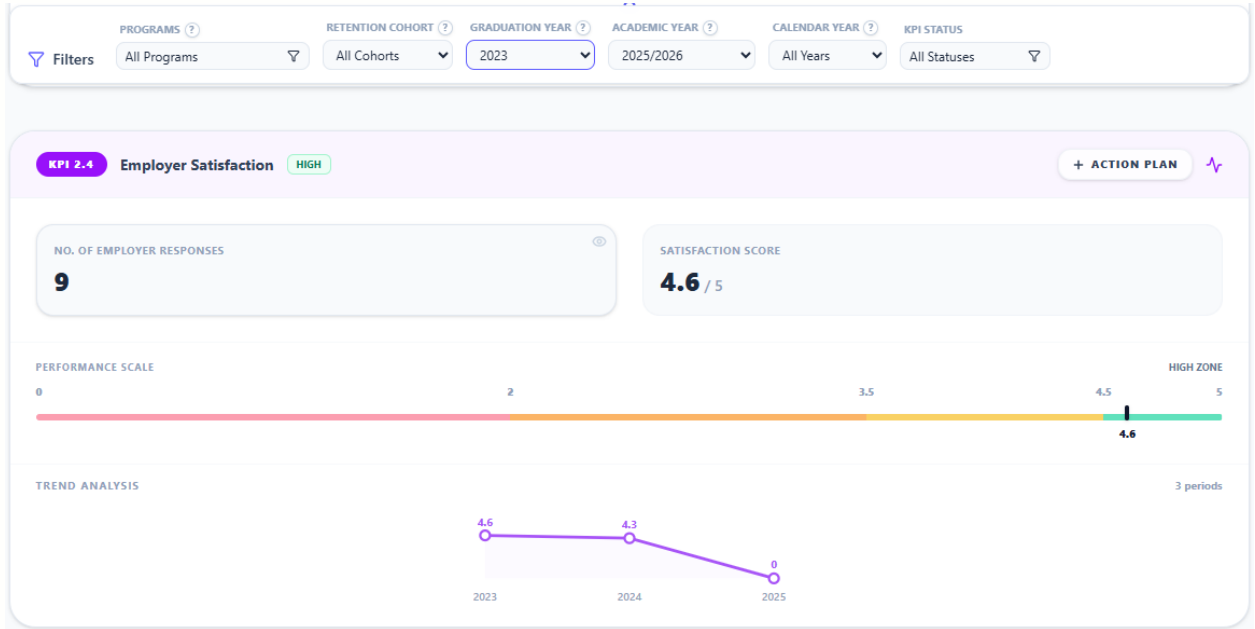

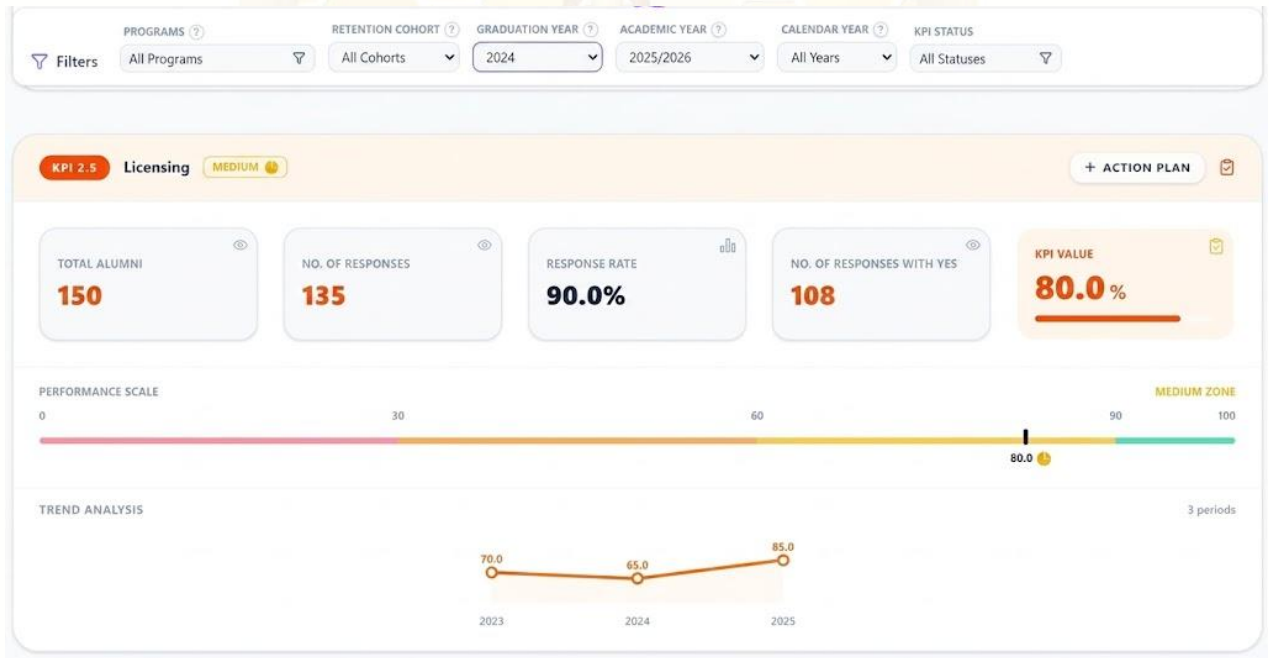

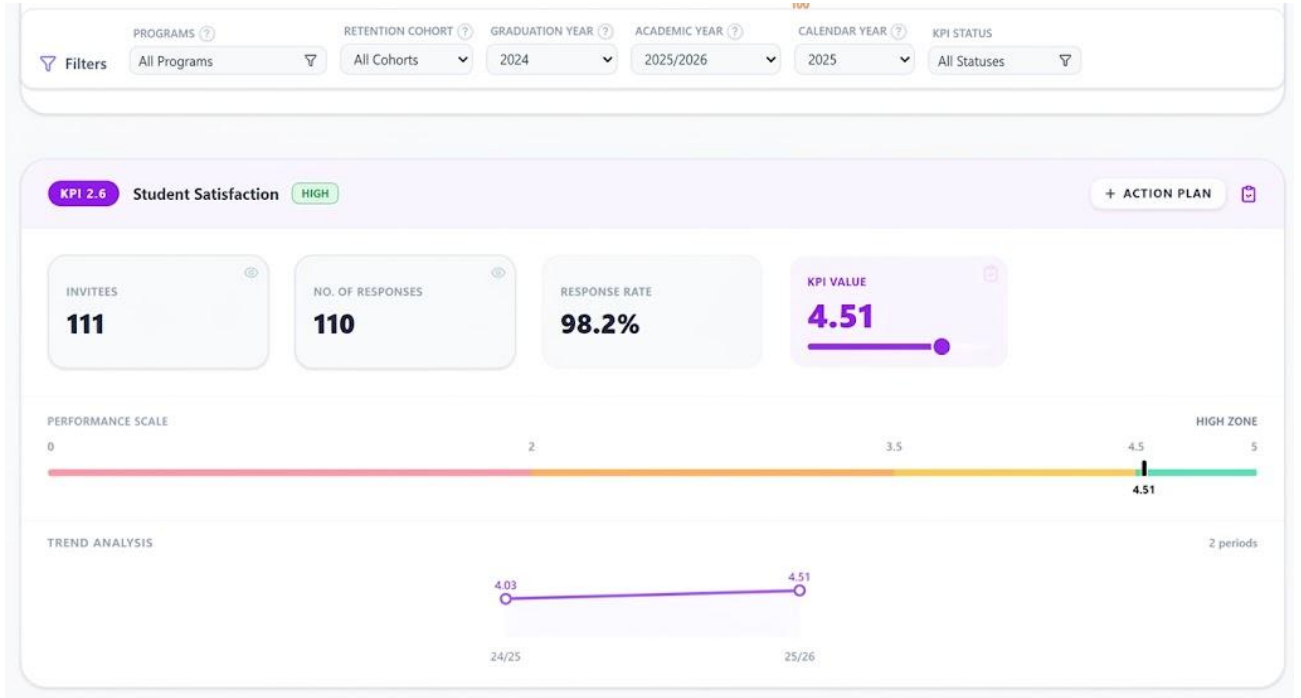

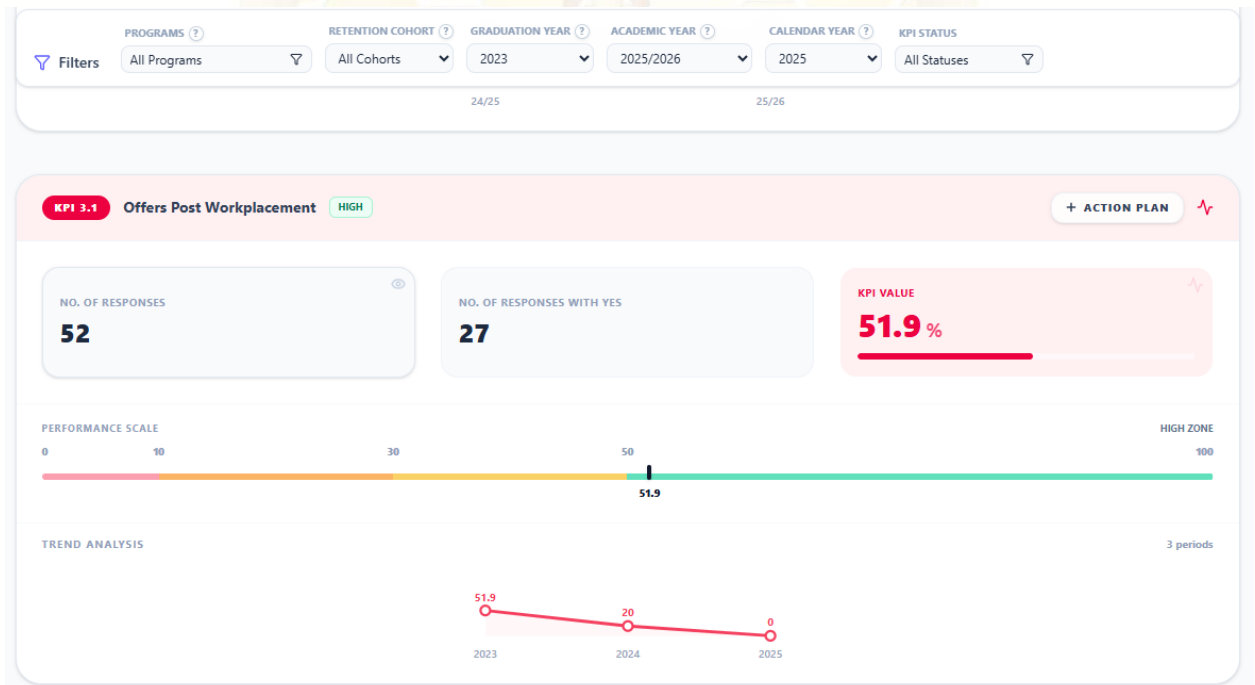

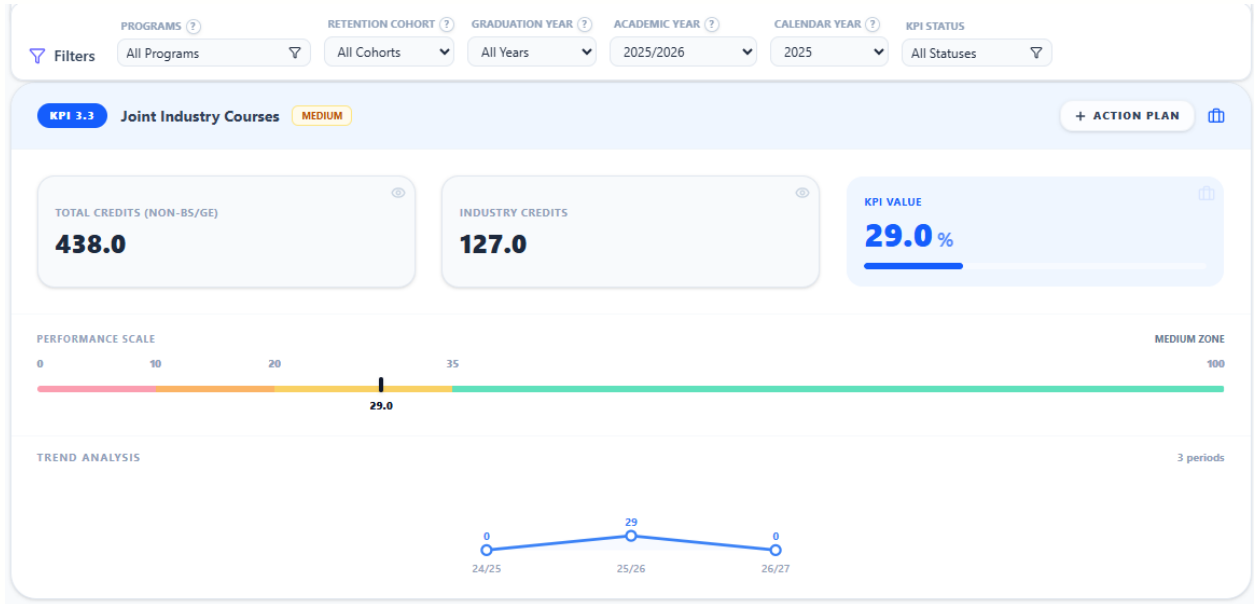


### KPI 3.1 Offers Post Work placement

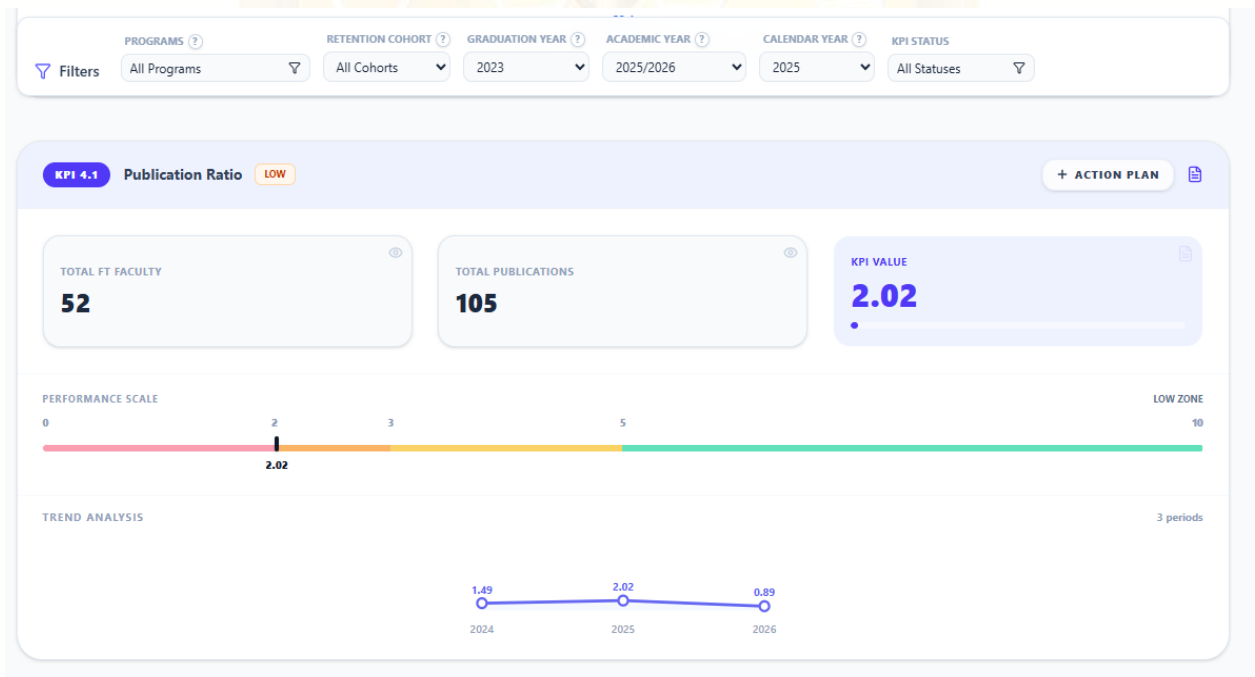




### KPI 3.3 Joint Industry Courses

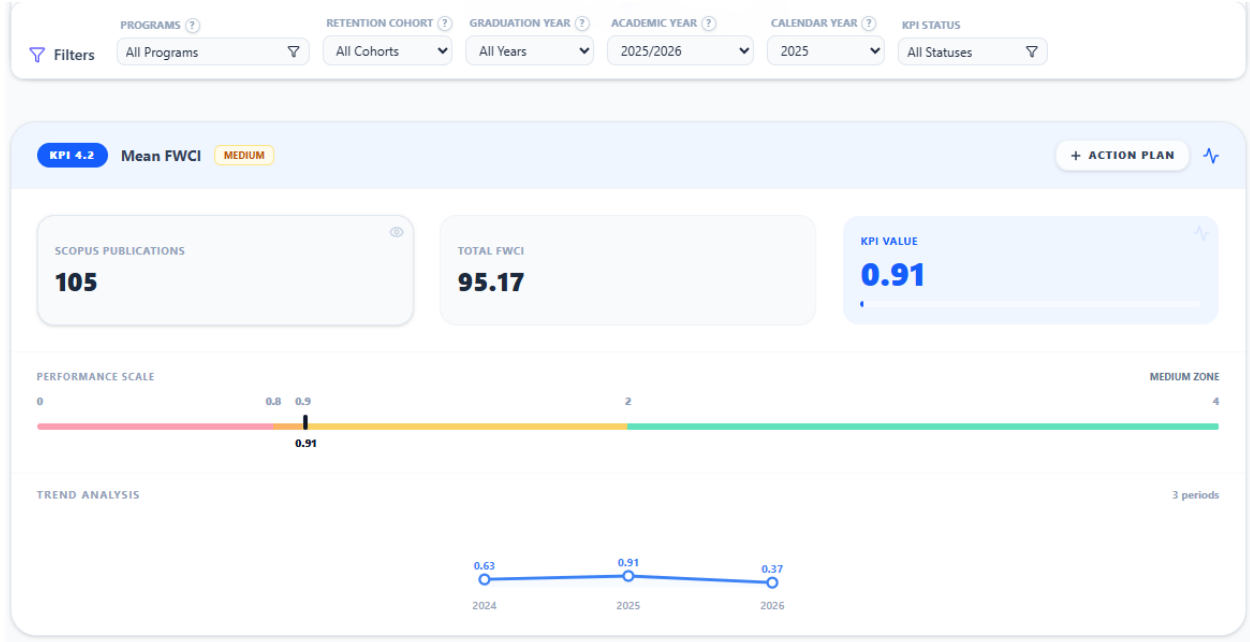


### KPI 4.1 Publication Ratio

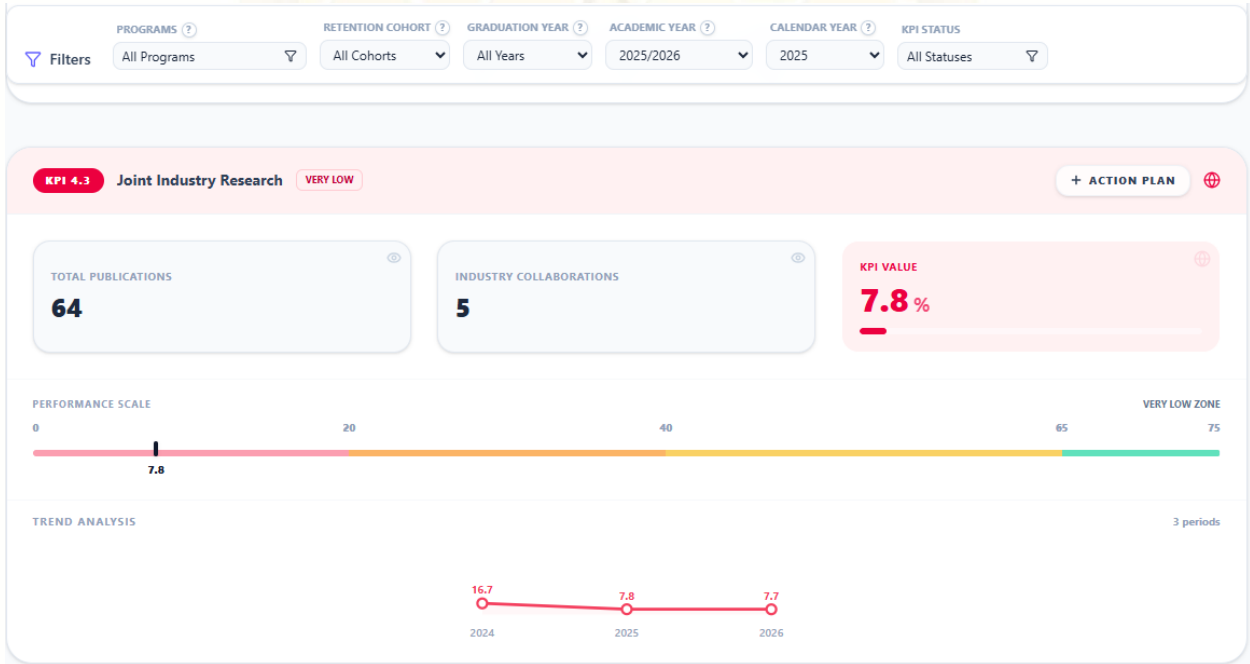




## KPI 4.2 Mean FWCI

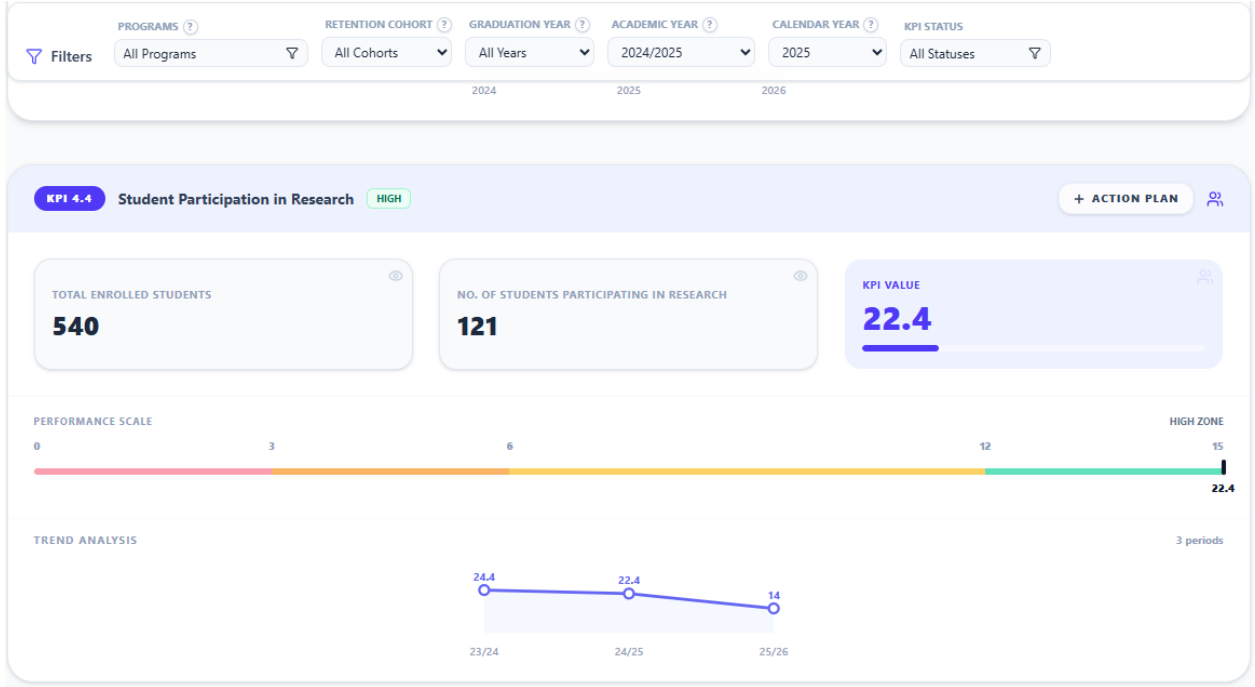

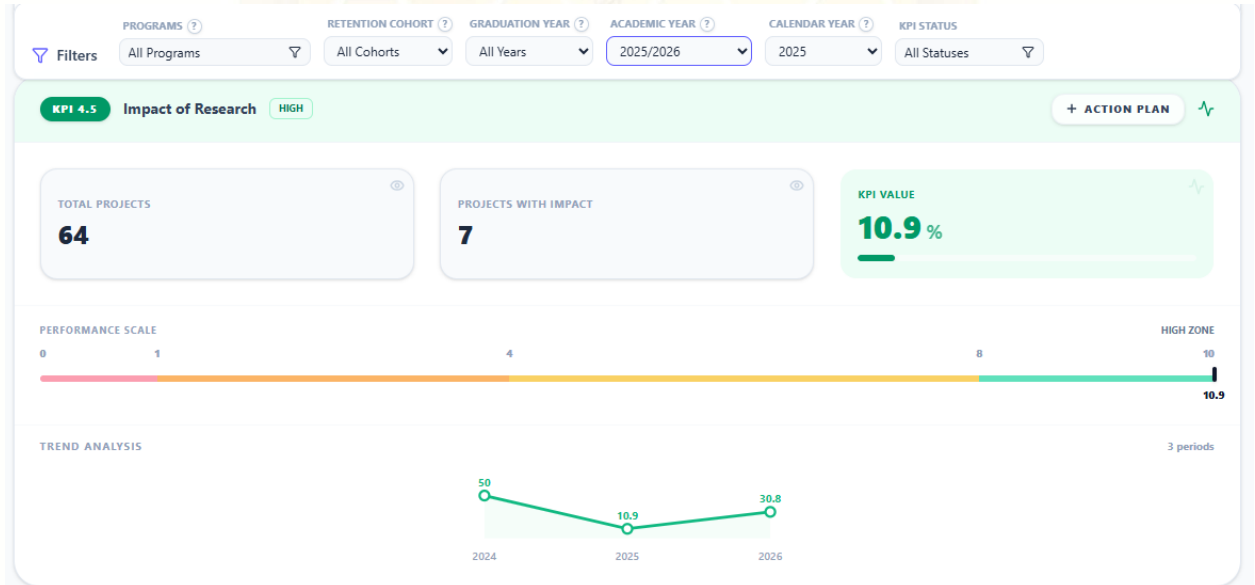




### KPI 4.4 Student Participation in Research

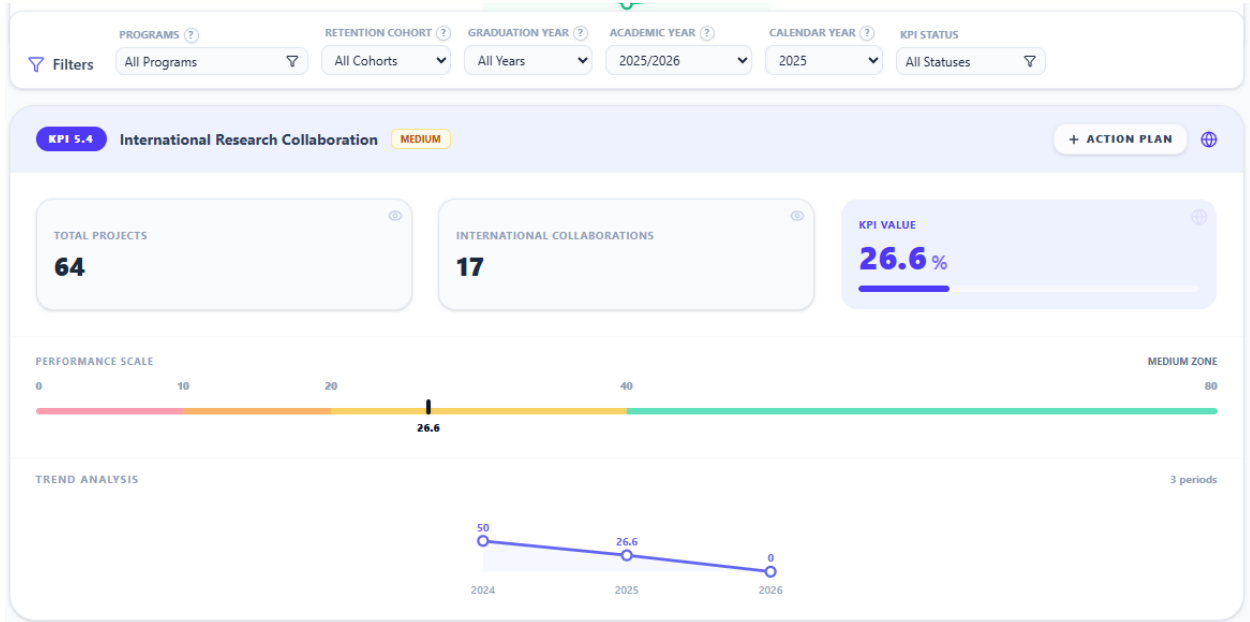

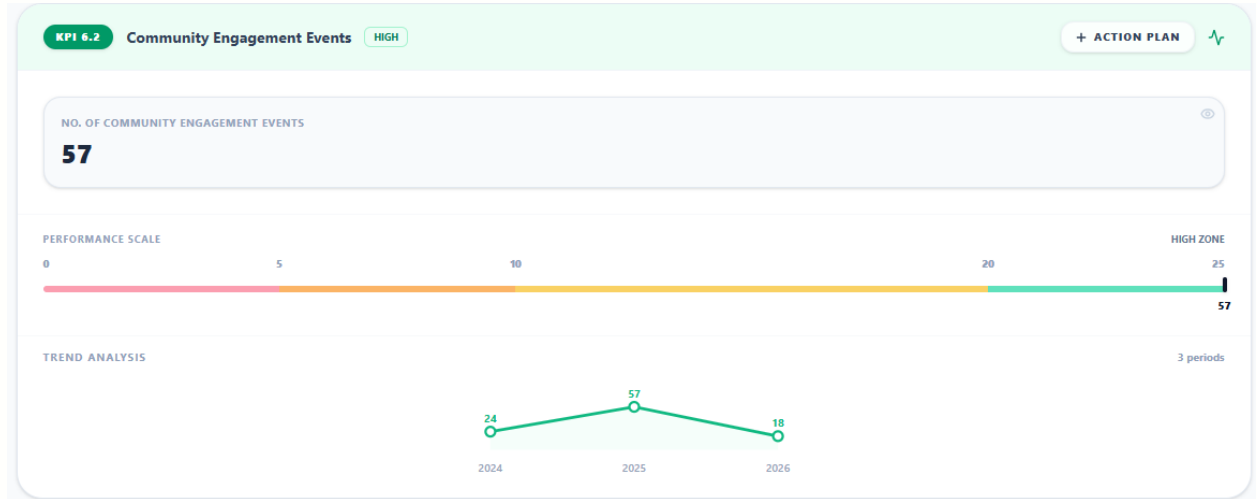
